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Demolition and Asbestos Renovation Guidance

What Buildings Are Subject:

Essentially all buildings are subject to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos National Emissions Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP) Regulations with the exception of some single family residences. Single-family residences that are going to be burned, have been used as a business, or are part of a larger project including other houses or businesses on the same site are subject to the Asbestos NESHAP Regulations.

Requirements:

All subject buildings must be "thoroughly inspected" for the presence of asbestos. This generally requires an asbestos survey by a Florida licensed asbestos consultant.

All subject demolitions (removal of a load bearing structural member) must submit an original Notice of Demolition or Asbestos Renovation form (see link below). Notices should be submitted to the district or county where the project is located (see the second link below to the state-wide Asbestos NESHAP Contacts). A Notice of Demolition or Asbestos Renovation form is required for a subject demolition even if no asbestos is found in the building. In addition, any regulated asbestos containing material (RACM) found in the building would need to be abated by a Florida licensed asbestos contractor prior to the demolition.

All subject renovations (no load bearing removal) must submit a Notice of Demolition or Asbestos Renovation form if over 160 square feet or 260 linear feet of RACM are to be abated. Again, notices should be submitted to the district or county where the project is located.

All Notice of Demolition or Asbestos Renovation forms must be submitted at least 10 working days prior to the start of any renovation or demolition activities.
