CODE ENFORCEMENT LIEN AMNESTY PROGRAM

FACT SHEET

The City of Clewiston is offering the Code Enforcement Amnesty Program as an incentive to property owners who may have outstanding Code Enforcement violations to bring their property into compliance with City codes and obtain quick reduction of the outstanding liens.

- The City of Clewiston (the "City") recently approved the Code Enforcement Lien Amnesty Program (the "Program") to accept applications from **April 1, 2024 to June 30, 2024.**
- > Commercial and residential properties are eligible to participate in the Program.
- Owners of complied properties that have outstanding liens by the City as a result of Code Enforcement violations may settle their debt on each Code Enforcement case subject to Program guidelines which include, but are not limited to, their property being inspected by the City and found to be in compliance, the City's receipt of a completed Code Enforcement Program Application and Participation Agreement by June 30, 2024, and timely paying the awarded reduced amount of the lien's face value.
- Owners of properties with ongoing Code Enforcement violations are eligible to participate in the Program subject to its guidelines, which include, but are not limited to, their property being found in compliance by the City and a completed Code Enforcement Program Application and Participation Agreement being received by the Community Improvement Division by June 30, 2024.
- > Only liens resulting from code violations are eligible under the Program. Liens arising from Unsafe Structure Board or Property Maintenance actions are not eligible. These liens must be paid in full prior to the property owner applying for the Program.
- Utility liens are not eligible for the Program.
- Owners must not have active Code Enforcement violations on any property owned in the City of Clewiston.
- Property owners with multiple Code Enforcement liens on a property must apply for a reduction of each lien on the property simultaneously under the Program.
- Submit the completed application and participation agreement form by June 30, 2024.
- Payment must be in the form of a cashier's check or money order and made payable to the "City of Clewiston." All Amnesty payments are due in full on or before September 30, 2024.
- The Program is being administered by the City's Community Improvement Division. Hours of availability are 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily, excluding weekends and legal holidays. You can schedule an appointment to discuss specific information or amounts owed by contacting the Community Improvement Division as noted below:

I recognize and fully understand that a code enforcement lien from code enforcement fines exists on the Property and, if approved, I wish to pay a reduced amount of 90% of the face value of the lien. I also understand that in order to participate in this Program and be eligible for the aforesaid reduction that: (i) all violations on the subject property must be complied; (ii) there cannot be any other active code enforcement cases with ongoing violations pending on any other property I own within the City; and (iii) I am completing one Application and Participation Agreement for each lien on the Property.

If approved, I agree to pay the total sum of the following items: the reduced value of the eligible lien(s) on the Property, the full amount due for any lien that was reduced by Order of the Special Magistrate, and the cost per lien of lien preparation and recording. I will make such payment to the order of the City of Clewiston and understand and agree that payment in full by cashier's check or money order must be received by the Community Improvement Division on or before **September 30, 2024**. Should I fail to make payment in full **by September 30, 2024**, I understand and agree that the approved lien reduction(s) shall be null and void and that I will be liable for the entire face value of the lien(s) as if no reduction had ever been imposed.

In addition, I understand that this agreement is not assignable by me. I also recognize that this Program only addresses code enforcement liens and not any other City liens which may be levied against the Property including, but not limited to, utility, special assessments, unsafe structures, and nuisance abatement liens.
