# **Public Works Director Sean Scheffler reports:**

- Mosquito Control: Trap counts: Golf Course 700; Okeechobee Blvd. 600; and Saginaw 350. The ground truck is scheduled to spray Friday night.
- Street Division: (1) Old plant material around the Sikes building was removed and the area was cleaned up. (2) Missing Royal Palms were replaced on Royal Palm Avenue. (3) The Bottlebrush trees in the Sports Complex have been topped in hopes of them coming back in better shape. (4) Staff built a shell rock apron at the lift station in Ridgewood.
- <u>Sidewalk Project</u>: Only one bid was submitted and was over budget. The Commission rejected the bid and wants to rebid the project.
- **Sports Complex:** (1) Staff called for locates at the intersection of Carmita and Arroyo so that Chinese Fan Palms can be planted around this intersection to help hide the maintenance area from the public.
- <u>Facility Maintenance</u>: (1) A small "shadow box" fence was built on the south side of the Youth Center to hide tipper carts.
- Parks & Playgrounds: (1) The old edging around the now gone play structures in the Trinidad Park were removed. Their condition made them a "trip hazard" and served no purpose.
- Reminder from Public Works: According to Sec. 102-118 of the City's Code of Ordinances, residents are responsible for the maintenance of the rights-of-way (ROW) adjacent to their property. Maintenance means: to keep all litter picked up; grass mowed; sidewalk edged and free of obstructions. Broken sidewalks from normal use will be repaired by the City. Sidewalks broken from residents crossing the ROW where there is no apron will be the responsibility of the property owner.
